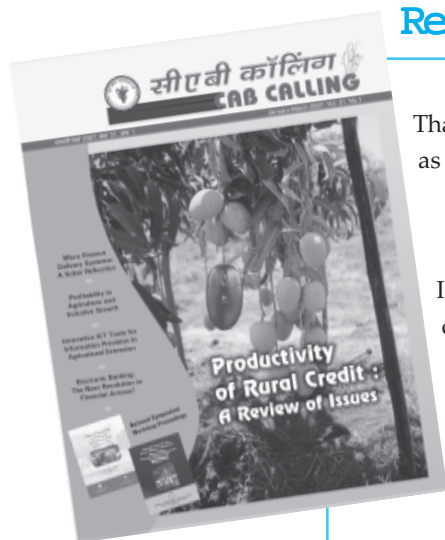


Response From Readers, Participants and Guests
